

## Fact Sheet: Respirators to Fit Test with Irritant Smoke

Respirator Type	OSHA Accepted for Irritant Smoke Fit Test*
Half Face Mask negative pressure, APR (100 fit factor)	Yes
<b>Full Face Mask</b> negative pressure, APR (100 fit factor) used in atmospheres up to 10 times the PEL	Yes
Powered Air Purifying Respirator (PAPR)	Yes
<b>Supplied-Air Respirator</b> (SAR) used in positive pressure (pressure demand mode); IDLH atmospheres	Yes
<b>Self Contained Breathing Apparatus</b> (SCBA) used in positive pressure (pressure demand mode); structural firefighting; IDLH atmospheres	Yes
<b>Disposable Particulate Respirators</b> : (N100) - filters at least 99.7% of airborne particles. Not resistant to oil (R100) - filters at least 99.7% of airborne particles. Somewhat resistant to oil (P100) - filters at least 99.7% of airborne particles. Strongly resistant to oil	Yes
Mouth Bit Respirators	Fit Testing Not Required
Loose Fitting Respirators e.g. hoods, helmets	Fit Testing Not Required
